- 1. Who is eligible? All RVers
2. Where is the RV Dump Site Located? City & County of Broomfield Wastewater Treatment Facility
3. What is the cost? Broomfield Residents - Free with proof of residency
4. What are the hours of operation? Open Year Round

- 5. Prohibited - Food Trucks and Commercial Waste Haulers
6. Procedure for using the dump station:
- First time only - Check in at the Wastewater Treatment Facility Administration Building.
- Recreational vehicle must have a discharge hose in order to avoid unnecessary spillage problems.
- Illegal dumping and discharges may result in fines per the City & County of Broomfield Municipal Code Chapter 13-28 Wastewater.
- Keep children and/or pets confined to your RV.
- Place permit sticker on lower passenger corner of front windshield, expires one year after issue date.
