The City and County of Broomfield Neighborhood Grant Program was developed to promote neighborhood identity and beautification and create community camaraderie.

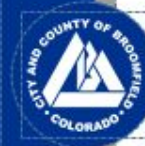
The grant program can be used to assist with material and equipment costs for physical improvements up to \$2,500 for groups or neighborhoods.
