How this Travel or Training Benefited the Citizens of Broomfield:

The Symposium brought together an international group of experts to discuss and comment on the state of cyber security in the world. In particular, it dealt with the threats to the digital systems of governments, private sector and the military. Gov Hickenlooper chaired a 5 member panel on an overview on Cybersecurity being integral to government and business, what resources are available and what legislation and policy are necessary to combat this evolving threat.

Sums Nallapati, Colorado's Secretary of Technology and CIO described Colorado's strategies and explained the multi layer approach to cyber security and the need for partnering with other organizations.

AI and the IoT (artificial intelligence and the Internet of Things) were deeply discussed as to their inherent lack of security and unintended consequences that likely will result.
