Brunner Farmhouse (1908) - Resolution No. 2006-168

The building exemplifies the typical farmhouse architectural style built in the early 1900's. The farmhouse is associated with the Brunner family, one of Broomfield's earliest families.

- Location: 640 Main Street, Broomfield
- Current Use: Community Gathering Place and Gardens



Crescent Grange (1916) - Resolution No. 2018-65

The building showcases and honors the agricultural heritage of the community, and represents the farmers and ranchers that established Broomfield. The Grange supported efforts such as food and clothing distribution during times of need and WWI and WWII efforts to support soldiers and families.

- Location: 7901 W. 120th Avenue, Broomfield
- Current Use: Community Gathering Place, Programing, and Gardens



Depot Museum (1909) - Resolution No. 2006-166; 5BF.80

The building was once operated as a railway depot with living quarters for railway employees. The Depot Museum exemplifies Broomfield's cultural, economic, and social heritage.

- Location: 2201 W. 10th Avenue, Broomfield
- Current Use: Museum



Honey House (1905) - Resolution No. 2006-167

The building was used in association with the Crawford family's honey business, where they kept about 500 colonies of bees. The family sold honey from the house. The Honey House exemplifies Broomfield's cultural, economic, and social heritage.

- Location: 2201 W. 10th Avenue, Broomfield
- Current Use: Museum Exhibit



Westlake School (1919) - 5BF.1

The building replaced the original 1902 schoolhouse to serve the growing farming communities in Adams County through the 1950's. Social events such as weddings, holiday celebrations, and community dances were held at the school.
