



## **WARNING:**

**Access to a firearm in the home significantly increases the risk of death by suicide, death during domestic violence disputes, and the unintentional death of children, household members, or others.**

## **EXTREME RISK PROTECTION ORDERS:**

**If you believe someone poses a significant risk of causing injury to themselves or others in the near future with a firearm, contact your local police department for information on Extreme Risk Protection Orders per C.R.S. 13-14.5-101, et seq.**

## **SECURE STORAGE:**

**Per C.R.S. 18-12-114, firearms must be responsibly and securely stored when they are not in use to prevent access by unsupervised juveniles and other unauthorized users.**

**Unlawful storage of a firearm is a class 2 misdemeanor.**

## **REPORTING LOST/STOLEN FIREARMS:**

**Per C.R.S. 18-12-113, a person who owns a firearm and who has reasonable cause to believe that the firearm has been lost or stolen shall report such fact to a law enforcement agency not more than five days after discovering that the firearm has been lost or stolen.**

**Failing to report a lost or stolen firearm is a civil infraction.**
