

**NOTICE TO MUNICIPAL COURT DEFENDANTS PURSUANT TO C.R.S. §16-4-113 STATUTORY RIGHT TO A PERSONAL RECOGNIZANCE (PR) BOND**

You are entitled to release on a personal recognizance bond at your next appearance if:

- You are charged with a traffic offense, petty offense, or comparable municipal offense;
- You are charged with a municipal offense that is a property crime and the factual basis reflects a value of less than \$300.00;
- The municipal offense does not have a comparable state misdemeanor offense. If you are charged with one of the above offenses and are unable or unwilling to post the monetary conditions of bond prior to your appearance before the Judge, the Judge will release you on a personal recognizance bond.

If you fail to appear in court as required or violate a condition of release, a warrant with monetary conditions of bond may issue for your arrest.
