



October 20, 2023: A Colorado woman is facing several counts of vehicular homicide in connection with a fatal crash on I-25 earlier this month that took the lives of two people.

The suspect, whose identity is not being released at this time because she remains hospitalized, will be charged with two counts of Vehicular Homicide with DUI, two counts of Vehicular Homicide Reckless, one count of Vehicular Assault DUI, one count of Vehicular Assault Reckless, DUI, and DUI Per Se. The 17th Judicial District Attorney's Office has accepted the charges.

The crash happened on Friday, October 6, around 10:15 pm on NB I-25 at mile marker 228 between 144th Avenue and Highway 7. The investigation revealed the suspect was driving under the influence of alcohol when she hit a vehicle parked on the side of the roadway for a flat tire.

Two adults, one inside of the parked vehicle and one outside, sadly lost their lives as a result of the crash. They were pronounced deceased at the scene. An additional three people, including the suspect and a young child, were taken to local hospitals with serious injuries.

Out of respect for the family, the names and ages of the deceased will be released by the Broomfield and Adams County Coroner.
