



December 9, 2022: The Broomfield Police Department has arrested a suspect accused of taking photos under women's dresses while they were shopping in the area of the Flatiron Crossing Mall, in November.

Thirty-year-old Jacob Padilla-Lesperance was arrested on November 27, 2022 and booked into the Broomfield Detention Center on the charge of Invasion of Privacy, a class two misdemeanor. Padilla-Lesperance has since posted bond. A female victim reported to police that an unknown male had been taking a video up her dress while she was shopping at the mall in late November. Padilla-Lesperance was identified and later arrested at his home in Broomfield.
