



December 1, 2022: The Broomfield Police Department is investigating a series of commercial burglaries that occurred over the weekend.

In total, 11 burglaries were reported between Saturday, November 26 and Monday, November 28. During each of the incidents, the suspect(s) broke into the business when it was closed by throwing a rock through a window or using a pry bar on the door. Cash was taken from several of the businesses, but nothing else.

At this time, detectives believe the same suspect(s) are responsible for burglaries at the following locations:

- 1300 block of W. Midway Blvd.
- 1200 block of E. 1st Ave.
- 11400 block of Via Varra (2 separate businesses)
- 1400 block of Hwy 287
- 1300 block of Hwy 287 (2 separate businesses)
- 1000 block E. 10th Ave. (2 separate businesses)
- 2000 block of W. 136th Ave. 12900 block of Lowell Blvd.
