



September 26, 2021: The Broomfield Police Department continues to investigate Saturday's shooting outside the Walgreens store at Midway Blvd. and Zuni St.

The suspect, 19-year-old Broomfield resident Trevor Woodruff, was arrested on Saturday and is being held at the Broomfield Detention Center on one charge of First Degree Murder, two charges of Attempted First Degree Murder, and two charges of Assault in the First Degree with Injury.

Officers were called to the Walgreens just after 11:30 am Saturday on reports of shots fired in the parking lot of the store. Upon arrival they found an adult male deceased in the parking lot. Two additional people, an adult female and a juvenile male, were also shot and transported to local hospitals. The female was listed in stable condition and the male in critical condition.

Detectives continue to investigate the altercation that led to the shooting. No one inside the Walgreens was injured, and investigators do not believe the shooting was in any way connected to the store. Additional details are not available for public release at this time, including the names of the injured. The name and age of the deceased will be released by the Adams County Coroner.
