NEWS RELEASE 9/12/24: The Broomfield Police Department continues to investigate a shooting that occurred early Thursday morning at the Arista Flats Apartments at Central Court and Colony Row in Broomfield.

Officers were called to the complex just after 6:30 a.m. for a disturbance. Upon arrival, a man inside the unit could be heard yelling. Shortly thereafter, the suspect began to shoot at officers, into other apartments as well as the parking lot.

A reverse emergency notification ([LookOut Alert](#)) was sent to surrounding residents to shelter-in-place. Several units were evacuated as well.

A female victim was inside the unit with the suspect. We regret to inform the community that she was pronounced deceased from a gunshot wound after being taken to a local hospital. Her name and age will be released at a later time by the Broomfield and Adams County Coroner.

The 34-year-old male suspect was shot by law enforcement officers before being arrested. He was taken to a local hospital with serious injuries. Charges are forthcoming. Multiple law enforcement officers received minor injuries and were treated and released.

Several law enforcement officers fired their weapons during the incident. The [Critical Incident Response Team \(CIRT\)](#) of the 17th Judicial District is now investigating. Those officers have been placed on administrative leave per department policy.

The investigation is in the early stages. In an effort to preserve the integrity of the investigative process, no additional information will be shared at this time.

This is a large and complex crime scene. Roads and buildings in the area may remain closed for several more hours. Impacted residents who have not been able to return to their units can go to the Broomfield Community Center at 280 Spader Way for help and information.

The police department asks residents to call the non-emergency line at 303-438-6400 if they discover any items/damage that may be related to the crime when returning to their homes and/or vehicles.
