NEWS RELEASE 5/20/25: In an effort to provide clarity while also keeping the community informed, the Broomfield Police Department is releasing additional information about the ongoing investigation into the disappearance of Paul Aragon. Paul was living in his truck at the time he went missing. He is from the Aurora area and is believed to have been working in Lakewood or Littleton. Why his truck was found in Broomfield has yet to be determined.

A Broomfield Officer on routine patrol first spotted Paul's truck around 3:15 am on May 2 in a construction area off of Edgeview Drive, near the WoodSpring Suites. The engine of the truck was still running, lights were on and a dog was inside. Officers searched the surrounding area by foot and with a department drone but found nothing suspicious. Paul was not a guest at the hotel and did not answer when officers tried to reach him via phone.

Then, on May 3 just after midnight a second officer stopped to check on the vehicle and the dog. The truck was still parked with the dog inside. Concerned about the dog's welfare, the animal was removed and taken to a local shelter. The area was once again searched by foot and by drone. It was at this time Paul's mother was notified that her son's dog had been found. Five days later the police department was contacted by his mother who wanted to report Paul missing. She told detectives she had not heard from him since April 28 or 29 and that he "no showed" for work on May 5. An official report was filed and a bulletin was sent to surrounding law enforcement agencies.

Since then several tips have come into the department and leads have been followed up on. The investigation is ongoing, and detectives have been in regular communication with Paul's mother since the report was filed. At this time she is the family's primary contact. We understand that there may be additional questions or concerns. We kindly ask for your patience as many of the details are confidential and cannot be shared at this stage.
