NEWS RELEASE 6/5/25: The Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT) of the 17th Judicial District is investigating an officer-involved shooting that occurred Thursday, June 5, in Broomfield.

Officers were called to A Precious Child in the 7000 block of W. 118th Avenue just after 9:00 a.m. for a man who was in the parking lot threatening to hurt himself. Shortly after their arrival, officers noticed the man was holding a gun.

A Precious Child was placed on “secure mode” to keep employees and patrons inside the building safe. Several people were evacuated through the back door during the incident and were later reunited with their families nearby.

The department’s Crisis Negotiations Team (CNT) in coordination with a clinician on Broomfield’s Mental Health Co-Responder Team (BCORE) negotiated with the man for several hours in an attempt to resolve the situation peacefully.

Just before 1:00 p.m., an officer-involved shooting occurred, resulting in the man's death. The Broomfield and Adams County Coroner will release his identity when available.

The officers involved in the shooting were not injured, and will be placed on administrative leave per department policy.

The investigation is in the early stages. In an effort to preserve the integrity of the investigative process, no additional information will be shared at this time.
