



Volunteer Position: 2025-2026 Snow Pals

Position Description:

Snow Pals volunteers assist caretakers, fixed-income and low-mobility Broomfield residents with snow removal. This allows for:

- safety of the resident(s) and guests
- meets code compliance
- allows easy access for medical and emergency personnel

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensure at minimum sidewalks around the assigned residence are clear of snow within 24 hours after a storm or snowfall (Mid-October through April).
- Clear driveway and front porch area for client safety and ease of use by medical or emergency personnel.
- Volunteers will be in direct contact with the resident to establish communication methods going forward.
- Update information and regularly input hours into your VolunteerHub profile and other reporting documents as necessary.
- Represent City and County of Broomfield (CCOB) in a professional manner in keeping with Broomfield policies.
- Must pass a background check.

Qualifications:

Volunteers must be ages 18+, minors can volunteer with an adult or guardian. Must provide your own transportation and have a phone to be in contact with the Broomfield resident. Must be physically fit enough to do manual labor outside during cold weather.

Onboarding:

New volunteers will receive information about their assigned resident to contact and create a schedule/plan for the cold season.

Benefits for the Volunteer:

Great opportunity to give back to the community, get to know your neighbors and stay active! This position is resident-facing and as a volunteer you would get the opportunity to meet the resident(s) you support.
