PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION 2025/2026



The Early Learning Program is a preschool program for children ages 2 ½ - 5 years, licensed by the state of Colorado. Handbook and paperwork will be given out after 2025-2026 enrollment is complete. All paperwork **MUST** be complete, including a copy of your child's immunization record, by August 1, 2025.

Broomfield Early Learning has been rated a level five in the Colorado Shines program through the state of Colorado. All instructors meet the qualifications to attain the five-star rating, including a background in education and experience working in a preschool classroom setting. Our staff are educated professionals who provide a quality program for the children.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

All families must create a B-REX account before registering for preschool classes.

REGISTRATION

You may reserve your child's space for BOTH semesters by paying in full or arranging for scheduled monthly payments with a credit card (\$15.00 processing fee per semester for scheduled payments). Monthly payments will begin in September 2025.

If you decide to discontinue the program after the start of a semester, please note that cancellations are charged a \$10 cancellation fee.

Early Learning staff will send out a confirmation via email with your class confirmation. You will receive instructions on how to pay for your child's class through B-Rex.com.

REGISTRATION FEE

Please note that you will be charged a \$75.00 registration fee upon registration into an Early Learning program. This registration fee is not applied to your tuition. It is a one-time registration fee only.



Early Learning will be participating in the Colorado Universal Preschool Program for Pre-K students.

WHAT IS UNIVERSAL PRESCHOOL?

Universal Preschool (UPK) Colorado ensures that every child in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten is eligible for 10 hours or 15 hours of state-funded, voluntary preschool beginning in the 2024-25 school year. Parents will be able to choose between 10 hours or 15 hours.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR 15 HOURS OF FREE PRESCHOOL?

All four-year-old Colorado children are eligible for UPK Colorado in the year before they become eligible for kindergarten. CDEC uses a cutoff of October 1, 2025, meaning that a child who turns four before this date in the year they wish to enroll in preschool will be eligible for Universal Preschool in Colorado.

IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN UNIVERSAL PRESCHOOL, ALL FAMILIES MUST APPLY THROUGH THE STATE OF COLORADO. PRE-REGISTRATION (ESTIMATED FEBRUARY - MARCH)

During the application process, you will choose Early Learning Broomfield Community Center Or Paul Derda Early Learning Program as your only program choice. After choosing our program, the application will be sent directly to the State regarding your Early Learning choice.

Please note in your application if your child has a sibling with a provider and if you would like them to stay together.

To guarantee your spot with Early Learning, You will also need to follow the Early Learnings Registration Process. Parents will fill out a registration form. Once accepted, you will receive a confirmation email. You will then need to pay the \$75.00 deposit. When the State of Colorado approves your application for Universal preschool, you will receive a refund for the deposit, and preschool for the school year will be paid through the State's funding.

There is a choice to disregard the Universal Preschool State funding. Tuition can be paid in full, or you can choose scheduled payments. Classes on the schedule that do not meet the minimum number of hours required for the Universal Preschool program are being offered. Parents can choose to pay the tuition. EARLY LITTLE LEARNERS

This class offers preschoolers the opportunity to develop socially, intellectually, and physically. It is a “beginning” to the preschool world. Children must be toilet trained and not in diapers or pull-ups to be eligible for this class. Please be sure to NOTE the location of your child’s class.

LITTLE LEARNERS PLUS

This class is an extended class for preschool children. The structured theme curriculum emphasizes large motor, small motor, cognitive, science, and math life skills. “Zoo Phonics” will also be introduced to learn letters and sounds. Children must be toilet-trained and not in diapers or pull-ups to be eligible for this class. Please be sure to NOTE the location of your child’s class.
