Active Adult Trip Lottery Process (Residents Only)

Registration Details for Active Adult Trips (January to May 2026)

Active Adult trips will go through the lottery process in B-Rex. Register online (B-Rex.com), by phone or in person at the Paul Derda Recreation Center or the Broomfield Community Center between 7 am on Thursday, December 4 through Thursday, December 11 at 5 pm. The Lottery Spin will take place on Friday, December 12 at 8 am. During the lottery process, patrons will not be charged. B-Rex will randomly pick lottery registered patrons for each trip and patrons that are not picked will be placed on a waitlist. Patrons will be notified by RecConnect email if they have been selected for trips and at that time payment will be due. The final payment due date is Wednesday, December 17 by 5 pm. Unpaid trip balances after the final due date will be canceled and made available for patrons on the waitlists. Once the lottery has ended, any trips that are available will be up for grabs through the normal registration process. Non-Resident registration is Thursday, December 18 at 7 am. Pre-registration is required for all classes and trips.

All classes and trips are subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment is not met, the trip will be cancelled and you will receive a full refund on your account in B-REx. This will be communicated with an email.

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to departure time.

All arrival times on trips are approximate. We will make every effort to depart and arrive in a timely manner.

No smoking on vans or buses.

We encourage you to utilize the wait list process whenever possible.

Individuals on the waitlist will be contacted if spots become available and given first priority to added trips.

Registrations must be completed by the participating member. Trips are not transferable.

*****REFUND POLICY*****

An administrative fee of 10% is charged on any cancellation initiated by the participant before the cancellation deadline date. Credit card refunds are subject to a \$10 administrative fee and will be assessed on a case by case basis.

Patrons are not allowed to give up their reservation trip for someone else. You will need to contact the Recreation Coordinator and they will handle the process.

Cancellations initiated after the cancellation deadline date will not receive a refund, unless the space can be filled from the waitlist and a 10% processing fee will be incurred. If there is no wait list, a participant may transfer their reservation to another person only with the approval of the Recreation Coordinator (Kim Hollingsworth).

Complete registration information and full payment is required from any substitute participant before the original registration is issued a refund.

A refund is not issued if the participant fails to show up or misses the bus.

INCLEMENT WEATHER CANCELLATIONS - In the event of severe weather, please call the BCC at 303.464.5500 press 8 to make sure the facility is open and that your trip is being held. If the center closes or trips are canceled due to weather, a household credit will be issued.
